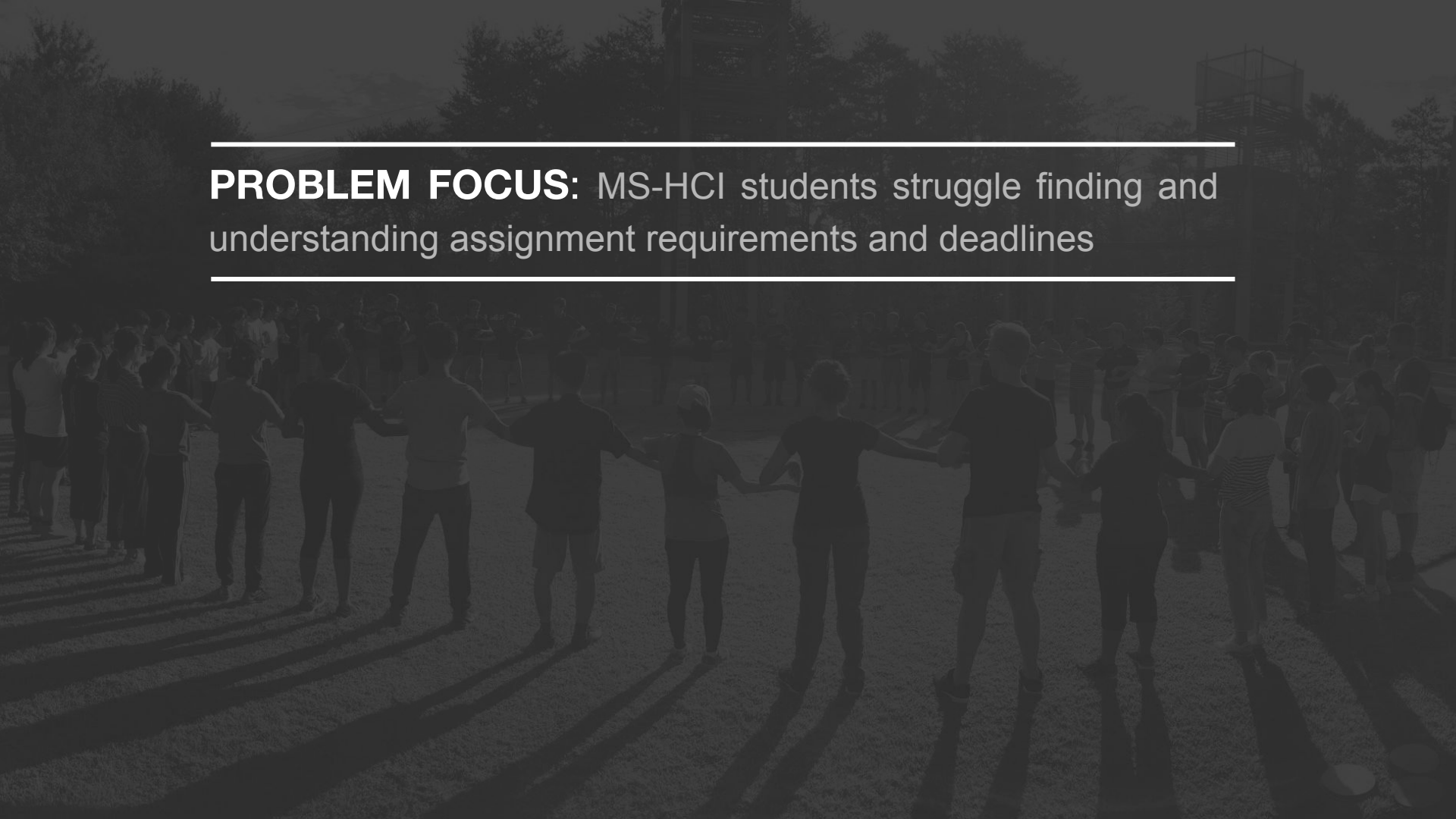

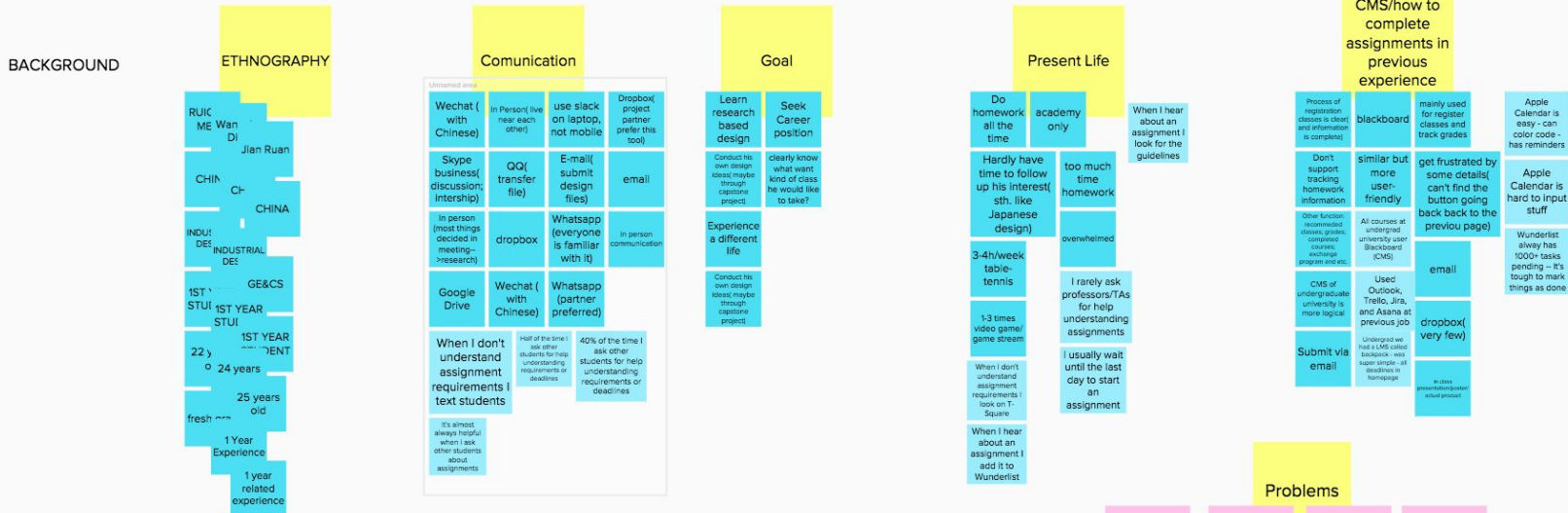
INTERVIEW ROUND #2

*“I wish I could just look **one place** and **find all the requirements and deadlines** [for assignments]. Life would be better... Like rainbows and puppies all around”*

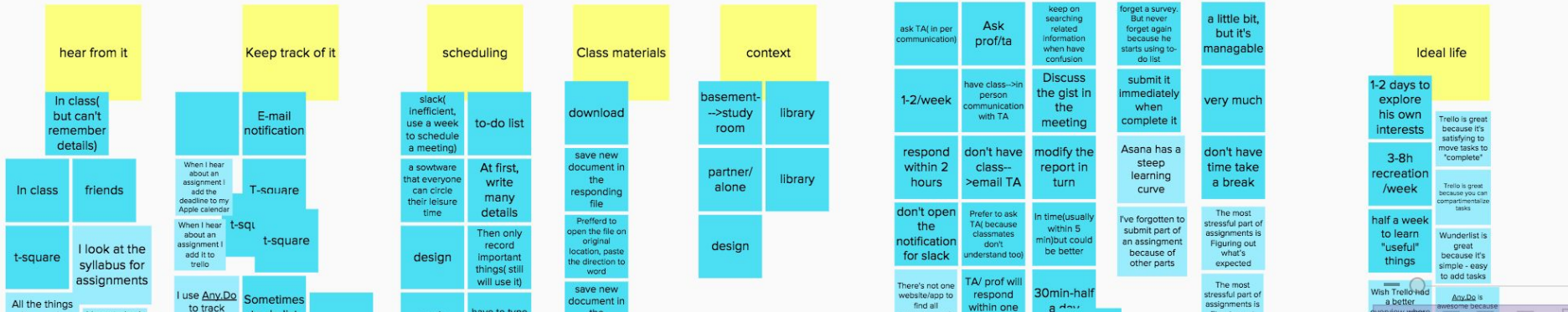

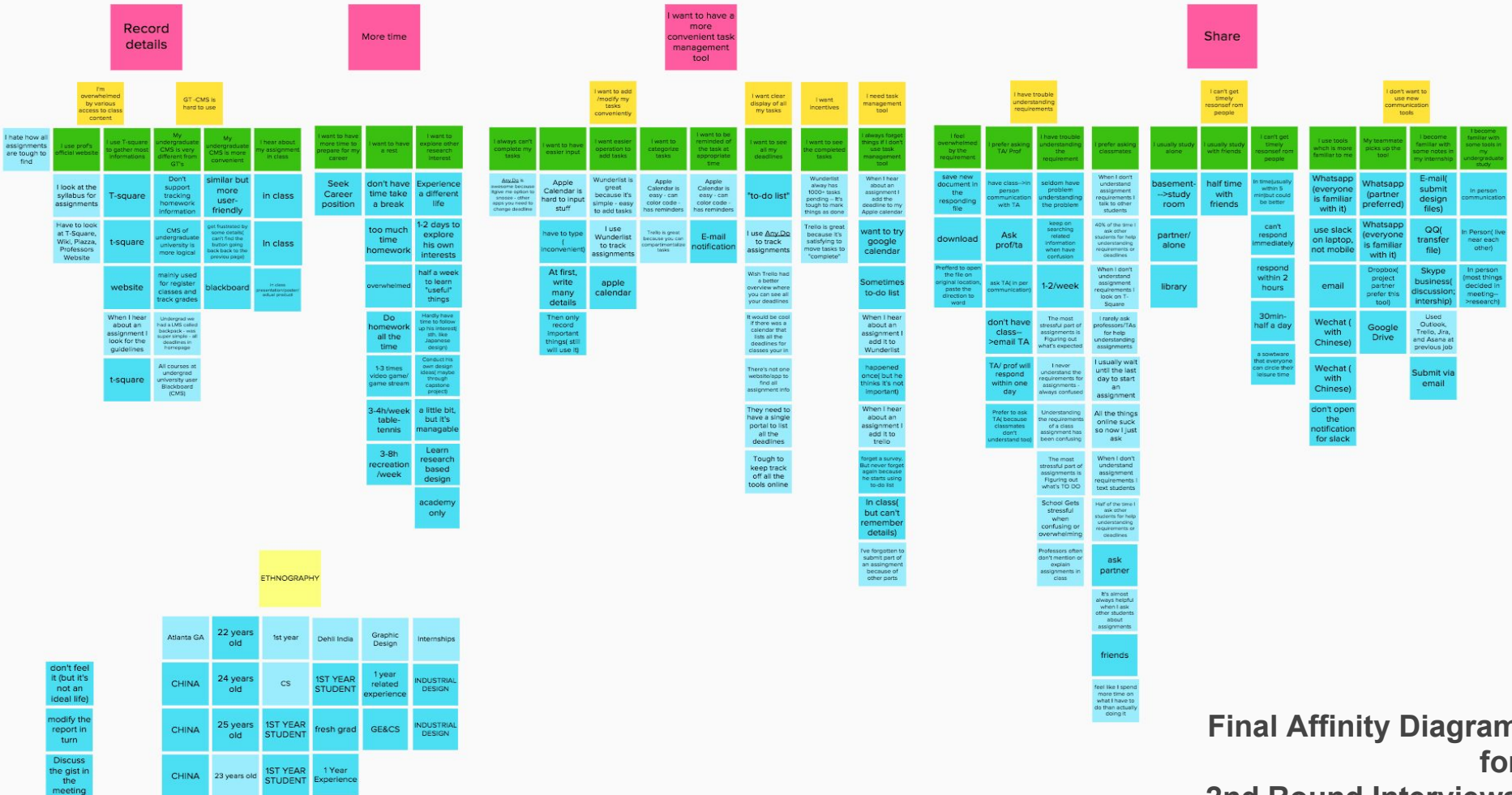

Process of completing of completing homework

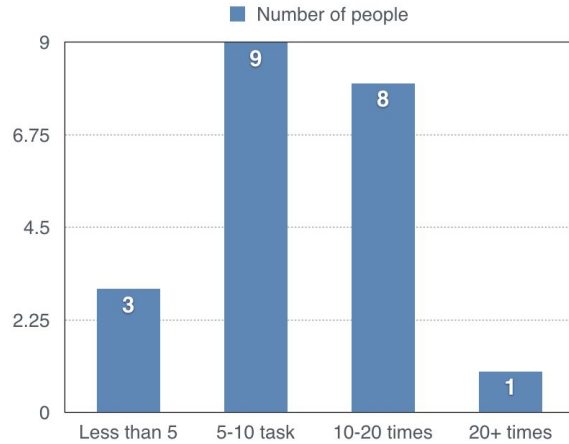




Final Affinity Diagram for 2nd Round Interviews

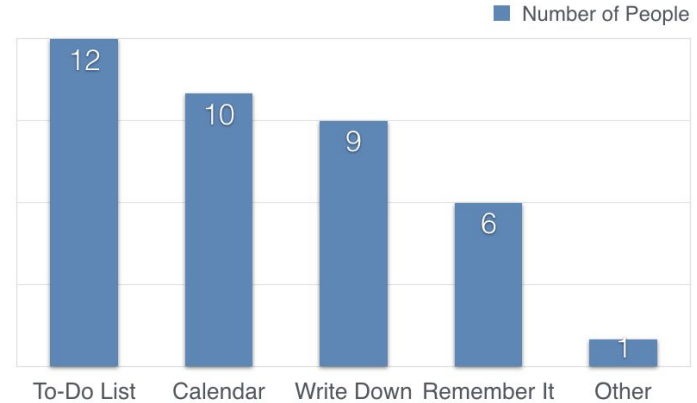
SURVEY DATA ANALYSIS

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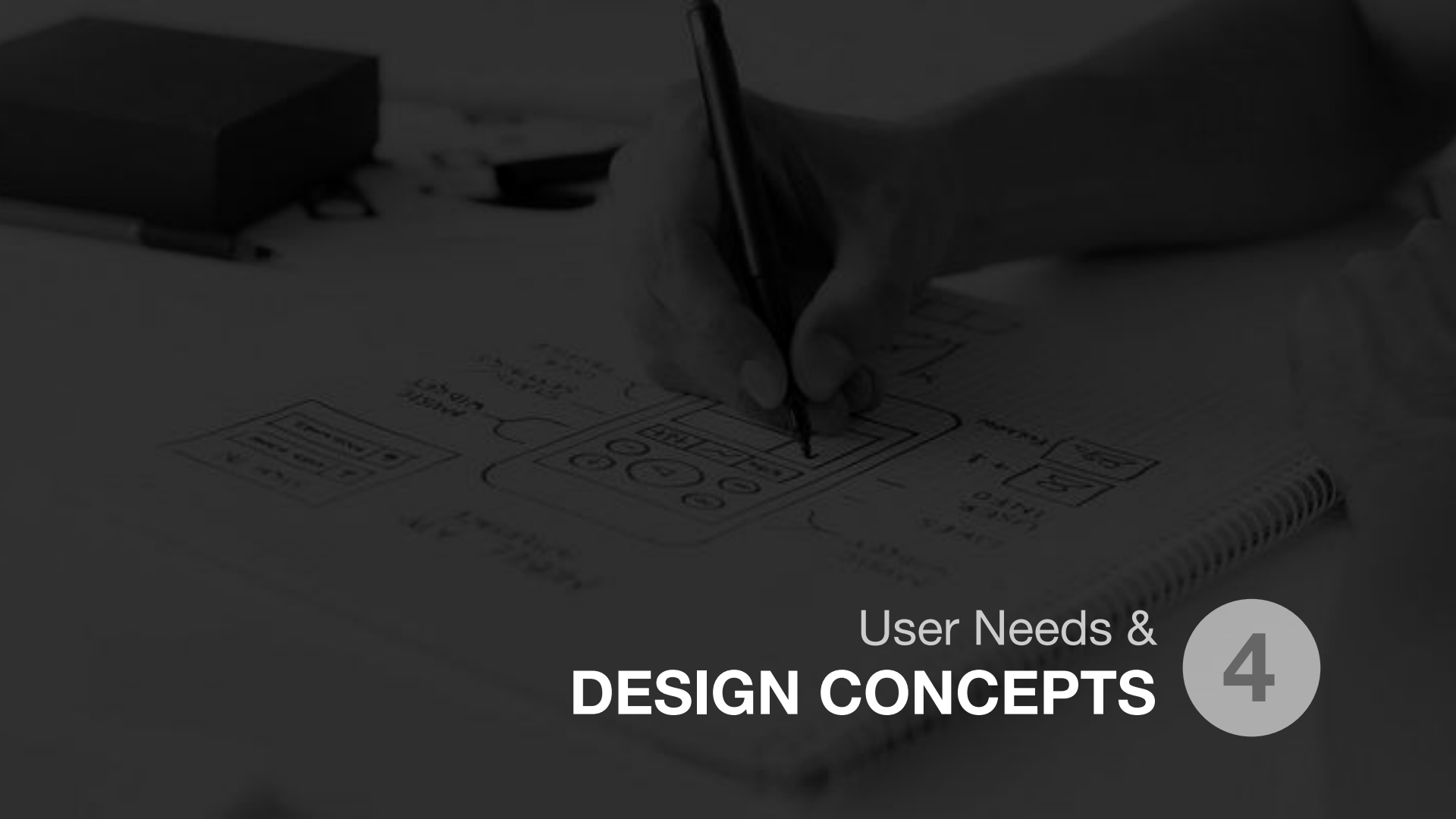
